GENERAL TUITION RATES

UNDERGRADUATES

The following per-credit semester tuition rates do not vary by college of enrollment and are the same for all undergraduate students. Degree-seeking undergraduates pay a flat tuition rate based on a minimum 13-credit load (including audited classes) and pay the student services fee, as well as a full technology/collegiate fee. Credits 1-12 are assessed at the per-credit rate only for students who have approval for a reduced credit load. Non-degree students are charged per credit for credits 1-12 and a flat tuition rate for 13 or more credits.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

The plateau for the Graduate School is 6-14 credits. No additional charge (except course fees) is made for 7-14 credits with this plateau. Each credit above 14 is assessed on a per-credit basis.

GENERAL FEES

UNIVERSITY FEE

The University fee helps cover costs related to instruction, student services, and academic support and is not dedicated to one particular need. All students are assessed this fee based on their enrollment, as follows:

- 1-9 credits—\$65 per credit
- 10 credits or more—\$650 flat fee

Undergraduates (including reciprocity students) who are classified as full time by their college are required to pay the full University fee regardless of their credit load. Students may appeal to their colleges for exceptions to full-time classifications.

STUDENT SERVICES FEE

All students enrolled for 6 or more credits must pay a student services fee of \$349.04 per semester, in addition to tuition. The fee is distributed among various student

programs that are listed online, along with their amounts, at onestop.umn.edu/finances/costs_and_tuition/tuition_and_fees/student_service_fees.html).

Courses that carry no degree credit and all audited courses are included in the credit total (one class hour equals one credit). Students in certificate academic plan or specialized/evening/part-time academic plan may be exempt (see your program office for more information).

Exemptions: Credits for off-campus, Learning Abroad Center/Office of International Programs, Online and Distance Learning courses, Minnesota English Center courses, and web-based/TV courses are exempt from the total credit count. Non-degree or post-secondary students are not required to pay the student services fee. However, students meeting the above exemption criteria may elect to pay the fee if they want to use or support the services covered by the fee.

Regents Scholarship recipients, as well as students in the Senior Citizen Education Program, are exempt and may not elect to pay the fee.
