

# Form W-9S

In order to have a 1098-T tax document generated for you, you must file your Social Security Number (SSN), or your Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), with the University of Minnesota.

The Privacy Act Notice, Section 6109 of the Internal Revenue Code requires you to give your correct SSN or ITIN to persons who must file information returns with the IRS. The IRS uses SSNs or ITINs for identification purposes and to verify the accuracy of tax returns.

To comply with this statute, please provide your UMN student ID number and complete Part I of Form W-9S, "Request for Student's or Borrower's Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification." Then return this completed form to the address listed on this form.

Do not include documentation. Based on the information you provide, the University will comply with IRS information reporting requirements related to the education tax benefits.
