

REQUEST FOR CCE NON-DEGREE ENROLLMENT AFTER SUSPENSION

DIRECTIONS—If you earned a bachelor’s degree elsewhere after your University of Minnesota suspension, you may use this form to request access to course registration as a non-degree seeking student in the College of Continuing Education (CCE).

If you wish to return to complete a degree at the U, do not use this form. You must work directly with the college that suspended you to discuss returning from suspension. CCE non-degree status is not an appropriate path for suspended students wishing to return to earn a bachelor’s degree.

Please note: Suspended students must wait one year before they are eligible to register for University courses or apply for readmission from suspension.

If you return to the University as a non-degree seeking student in CCE, the following applies:

Academic probation—You will be put on **academic probation** and have one semester to fulfill the probationary contract or you will be suspended for a second time and not allowed to continue to enroll.

Financial aid eligibility—State and federal financial aid may not be available. Contact One Stop Student Services for more information (z.umn.edu/contact).

Transfer credits—Credits you earn as a non-degree-seeking student in CCE are generally transferable credits, but are not automatically applicable to a University degree program.

Advising appointment—Once this form is signed by you and your college representative, contact CCE to set up an advising appointment, discuss eligibility for enrollment, and sign an academic probation agreement.
